The <u>Arenal Volcano</u> once erupted an average of 41 times per day. Today, the volcano is in a resting phase but still a sight to behold. The region is not only home to the volcano, it also benefits from volcano-fed thermal hot springs, plunging waterfalls, the impressive size of Lake Arenal, and a rich secondary rainforest ecosystem with exotic wildlife.

Now considered by many the <u>adventure capital of Costa Rica</u>, Arenal is a great base for adventure tours like zip-lining, whitewater rafting, waterfall rappelling, and more.

Arenal Hanging Bridges Hike

Hike across the Arenal Hanging Bridges with a naturalist guide for a perfect half-day Arenal tour. This ecotourism project of solid ground trails and state of the art hanging bridges was designed for the observation and conservation of Costa Rica's incredible nature. The reserve, with nearly 370 acres of rainforest, is home to countless species of amazing birds, mammals, and lush vegetation. You will walk along the treetops with your naturalist guide, encountering 8 fixed bridges and 6 hanging bridges. These connect gaps in the reserve canyon, allowing you to walk right into the most important layers of the rainforest.





Arenal Hanging Bridges 'Early Birds' Hike

This early morning tour is for those who wish to discover the magic of the rainforest just after sunrise. The Arenal Hanging Bridges is an ecotourism project of trails and bridges maintained for the observation and protection of nature. Explore the canopy of the rainforest with a professional ornithologist guide on a trail connected by 8 fixed bridges and 6 hanging bridges. It is not uncommon for birdwatchers to note between 50 & 60 species of birds during the tour. After the 2 ½ hour hike, you can discuss the species you spotted with your guide before heading back to your hotel.

<u>Arenal Hanging Bridges Hike & La Fortuna</u> Waterfall

The Arenal Hanging Bridges hike is a rainforest canopy experience through a private nature reserve with over 1500 acres of rainforest. Traverse a trail connected by 8 fixed bridges and 6 hanging bridges to uncover the magic of the rainforest and the importance of conservation. Keep an eye out for tropical birds, mammals, and reptiles on this local favorite nature hike. After lunch, head to the La Fortuna Waterfall. Enjoy the cascade from the observation point high above before walking down about 300 meters (400-500 stairs) to the base of the waterfall on a steep, paved pathway with several stairs. Once at the bottom, you will have the opportunity to snap some photos and even take a dip in the chilly waters. Please note: swimming is allowed in the river, but not near the cascade of the powerful waterfall!

Arena Sky Aerial Tram & Trek Zipline Tour:

The tour starts with the Sky Aerial Tram, a high-tech cable-car that brings you to the highest point of the Arenal Reserve. With rainforest canopy and the Arenal volcano as your backdrop, you will have time for photos before receiving a safety briefing. This part of the tour is the Sky Trek: a zipline adventure that allows you to observe the rainforest while zooming past trees. Fly through lush canopy across 8 cross-sectional cables that, together, have a total length of 4.5 miles and with a maximum height of 660 feet.



Pure Trek Waterfall Canyoning:

Begin with a brief safety talk before gearing up and embarking on a short trek to the top of the first waterfall where you start your descent. There are five rappels, four of which are along waterfalls, and one dry rock face, ranging in height from 50 to 20 meters, and are all promise to get your adrenaline pumping! Strap in for vertical water, lush jungle, occasional wildlife, and pure adventure!

Rio Balsa Whitewater Rafting (Class II-III)

About 1-1.5 hours from the Arenal area is the Balsa River, a perfect spot for first-time and experienced paddlers to enjoy class II and class III rapids. The dynamic on this river is typical of most rivers in the Northern Zone of Costa Rica: consistent Class III rapids for the first half, and less intense rapids (great for wildlife watching) in the second half. You might spot tropical birds and other mammals across the jungle landscapes that surround the river region. Enjoy a tasty lunch before returning to your hotel later in the afternoon.

You will transfer by ground approximately 1½ hours by ground to the Frío River, an important area for much of Costa Rica's wildlife. Float down the river peacefully as you try to spot monkeys, sloths, iguanas, turtles, caimans, and birds in this special eco environment. After, enjoy homemade snacks at a Costa Rican family farm and practice your Spanish skills with the owners before heading back to Arenal.

Sloths, iguanas, crocodiles, numerous tropical birds, and monkeys all await you on this adventure! A professional bilingual guide will accompany you to share educational explanations of the plants and animals you encounter. Traveling down the river without a motor, you will appreciate the peacefulness of the journey while rowing and taking pictures.

Arenal Volcano Hike

Start your hike on a rainforest trail that crosses on of the volcano's old lava flows from 1992. Thanks to the environment around the base of the volcano, you may also spot plants, and wildlife during the hike. Once you have reached the top of the lava flow, stop to enjoy a magnificent view of Lake Arenal. Follow your naturalist guide, who will explain the history of the volcano and help you spot interesting flora and fauna during your hike.

Rio Celeste Waterfall Hike:

You'll depart early in the morning for a 1 ½ hour drive to the Tenorio National Park. Here you'll begin the 5-mile hike (approximately 4 hours) through a tropical forest on paved stair pathways. Along the way, observe the volcano vents emitting gases. The grand finale of this hike is the magnificent Rio Celeste Waterfall and its famous blue waters. After lunch, you will head back to your hotel.

After, visit La Fortuna Waterfall. Grab some photos of the 70-meter cascade from the panoramic lookout point before trekking down to the base of the waterfall, which is equally beautiful. Wear your swimsuit and take a refreshing dip in the swimming hole. Careful on the rocks!
